

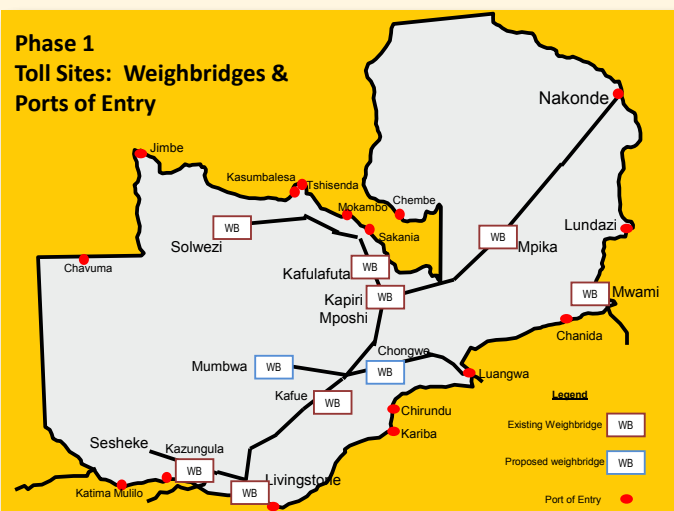
INTRODUCTION

In March 2011 the Tolls Act No 14 of 2011 was enacted to provide for the establishment and operation of Toll roads in Zambia. The Government through the Tolls Act No.14 of 2011 appointed the Road Development Agency as the Tolls Authority.

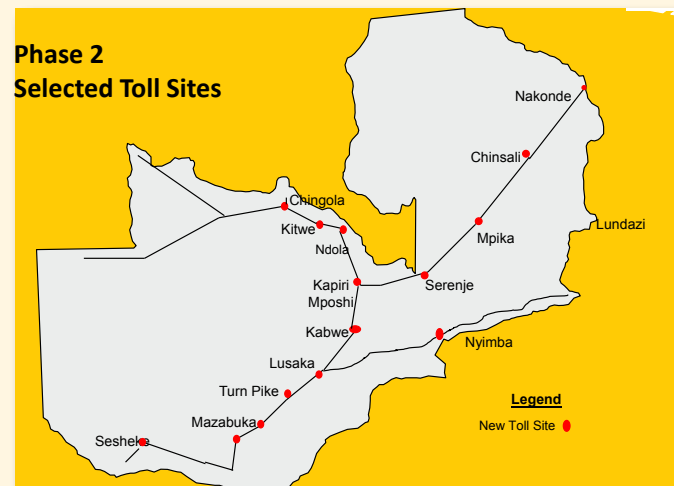
PRINCIPLE OBJECTIVE

IMPLEMENTATION STAGES



Phase 1 starts on 1st November, 2013 and will toll Classes II, III, IV, V & Abnormal loads.

TOLL TARIFF STRUCTURES

Classification of Motor Vehicles

Class 1 - Light vehicles: Light vehicles are motor vehicles, other than heavy vehicles less than 3,500Kgs and below 6,500Kgs, with or without a trailer, and include motor cars, vans, mini buses up to 15 seats. K10 - K15

Class 2*- Buses: With 24 seats and above K20

Class 3*- Medium heavy vehicles: Medium heavy vehicles are heavy vehicle, 16,501- 30,000Kgs with two or three axles. K25

Class 4* - Large heavy vehicles: Large heavy vehicles are heavy vehicles, 30,001Kg- < 56,000Kgs, with three or four axles. K40 - K60

Class 5 - Large heavy Vehicles: Greater than 56Mt. K80






Class 6 - Extra large heavy vehicles: Extra large heavy vehicles are heavy vehicles, as defined below including Abnormal loads, with five or more axles. > 70Mt= K160
> 100Mt= K250

*Classes 2- 4 are HGVs and mandatory to pass through Weighbridge

IT'S IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT:

1. Receipts should be demanded upon payment of toll fees
2. Toll fees displayed per vehicle classification are to be paid at each and every Toll Site. Alternatively, payment for the entire journey can be made at the starting Toll Point.
3. Toll collectors at Starting Toll Points will advise what the cost of your entire journey will be.
4. Phase 1 starts with laden vehicles in class 2 and above.

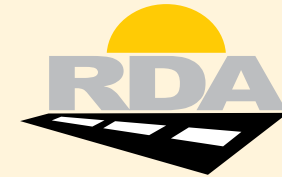
